Patient Case Study

Instructions: Collaborate as an Interprofessional team. Review the patient case study provided. Each team member should then select a role: *Researcher, Recorder and Reporter* - Where the <u>Researcher</u>: Inquires with faculty to clarify any medical or pharmacological questions; the <u>Recorder</u>: Keeps record of all responses from each team member and the <u>Presenter</u>: Takes the lead in presenting this case as recorded. The case should be presented as it occurred in Huddle at STAR Health Center.

Remember to consider all the medical, pharmacological and social aspects of care in order to develop a care plan for this patient. Some points to consider: What questions would you ask the patient? What medical or pharmacological questions do you have for faculty? What education would you provide to the patient and/or family?

Notes:

- a. What are the patient's current issues/barriers?
- b. What is the plan to address these issues/barriers?
- c. Which staff will be involved in the care plan?
