
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



STIs in Older Adults



PrEP – Needed for Older Adults?

- PrEP is effective for prevention of HIV transmission
- PrEP is recommended for persons who engage in risk behavior associated with HIV transmission
- STIs serve as a marker for risky behaviors
- Older people have sex
- PrEP is one of several HIV transmission risk-reduction methods



Sexual Counseling for Older Adults

- Talk about sex with older adults
- ✦ Identify who is at risk
 - ✦Offer STI screening, including HIV
- Counsel about risk-reduction methods
 - ✦Barrier protection
 - ✦Serosorting
 - HIV suppression for seropositive partner
 - Low risk sexual practices
 - +PrEP
