GOALS & OBJECTIVES

GOAL 1

- To improve the ability of health care providers and related programs and agencies throughout Region III to provide culturally and age-appropriate HIV-related services for racial and ethnic minorities
- Design and deliver four one-hour synchronous web-based training events
- Design two integrated centralized training events
- Design and deliver one mini-residency
- Explore interest amongst the health care providers and communities that serve racial and ethnic minorities in Region III, and assess their interest in participating in HIV integration capacity building initiative

Goal 2

- To support collaboration amongst the R3FTCC partners
- Facilitate an active R3FTCC workgroup with members from AETC, PTC, T3, TB RTMCC, ATTC, and VHTC to identify and respond to shared training needs throughout Region III
- Develop an inventory of existing HIV-related job aids and training materials that are available by the R3FTCC partners
- Develop a lessons learned document stakeholders

What is the FTCCAR?

The Federal Training Center Collaborative Atlantic Region is a collection of federally funded training centers serving the states of Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, Ohio, Virginia and West Virginia and the District of Columbia. These centers are funded through grants and cooperative agreements with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), and the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). Through a grant awarded to the Family Planning Council, Inc., the FTCCAR is working together to promote the integration of Services to health care providers throughout our service area.



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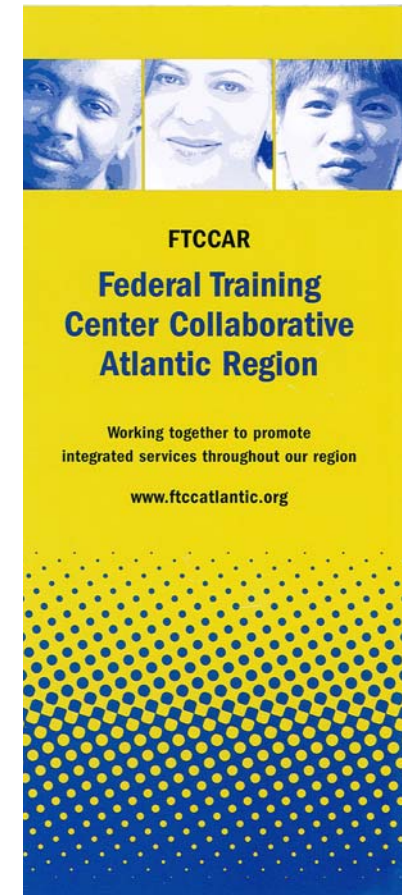
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LESSONS LEARNED
