

      A[Substantial Risk for HIV Acquisition] --> B[≤72 hours since exposure]
      A --> C[>72 hours since exposure]
      B --> D[Source known to be living with HIV]
      B --> E[Source of unknown HIV status]
      D --> F[nPEP IS RECOMMENDED as soon as possible]
      E --> G[Case-by-Case Determination]
      C --> H[Negligible Risk for HIV Acquisition]
      H --> I[nPEP NOT Recommended]
  
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Substantial Risk for HIV Acquisition
Exposure of vagina, rectum, eye, mouth, or other mucous membrane, non-intact skin, or percutaneous contact
With blood, semen, vaginal secretions, rectal secretions, breast milk, or any body fluid that is visibly contaminated with blood
When the source is known to be living with HIV

Negligible Risk for HIV Acquisition
Exposure of vagina, rectum, eye, mouth, or other mucous membrane, non-intact skin, or percutaneous contact
With urine, nasal secretions, saliva, sweat, or tears if not visibly contaminated with blood
Regardless of the known or suspected HIV status of the source

nPEP IS RECOMMENDED as soon as possible

nPEP NOT Recommended
